## LANDIS & GYR FOUNDATION – RESIDENCIES, TRAVEL GRANTS AND ARTIST GRANTS

Zug/international – In mid-December 2022, the LANDIS & GYR FOUNDATION is issuing its annual call for applications for a residency, travel grant or artist grant. Swiss artists and cultural professionals are invited to apply, as are non-Swiss citizens who have their official residence in Switzerland.

The 2024/25 residencies in Budapest, Bucharest, London and Sofia are awarded in the disciplines of literature, composition, cultural criticism, theatre (directing, dramaturgy, playwriting), dance and visual arts.

The 2023 artist grants are presented exclusively to solo artists or duos who are either currently working on or have plans to work on a specific project; there are no discipline-related restrictions. The prerequisite for both residencies and artist grants is a proven record of achievement.

The focus of the 2024 travel grants for the Balkans/Turkey region is a project-based approach to a socially relevant topic.
